Cartoon competition for 7 - 11 year olds

Competition rules

- 1. The competition is open to children aged 7 11 years
- 2. Entries can be from individual children or group entries from schools.
- 3. The strip cartoons must be designed to fit an A4 horizontal sheet of paper.
- 4. The aim is to tell a funny story in a cartoon strip of 3, 4 or 5 boxes.
- 5. They can be designed in black and white or colour.
- 6. A short video by Harry Venning with tips on how to draw a cartoon can be found on the Bath Institute of Laughter website www.bathlaughter.co.uk
- 7. Completed designs must be scanned and then emailed along with the appropriate entry form to info@bathlaughter.co.uk
- 8. Children may only submit one entry.
- 9. All entries must be received by Monday 20th March.
- 10. The judges will select the best entries to be displayed at an exhibition at the Commercial Hub, 15 New Bond Street, Bath from 29^{th} March until 6^{th} April.
- 11. The organisers cannot guarantee the return of cartoons.
- 12. Prizes of £25 Hobbycraft vouchers will be awarded to the best individual cartoons in two age categories: age 7 9 and age 10 11. The best school group entry will receive a prize of £100 in Hobbycraft vouchers.
- 13. Winners will be invited to a prizegiving ceremony at the Commercial Hub on Wednesday 29th March at 4pm.
- 14. The cartoon competition is part of **Junior Jokers**, a programme of events and workshops for young people funded by the Roper Family Charitable Trust. Programmed by the Bath Institute of Laughter which is a Making Theatre Gaining Skills project.
